Advances in Hepato Biliary Pancreatic imaging has revolutionized the diagnosis and therapy of many HPB diseases. Endoscopic techniques in this area are rapidly evolving and becoming the standard of care. This workshop aims at demonstrating many of these cutting edge technologies and techniques by international experts.

This three day workshop starts with a daylong video based Post Graduate Course to introduce ERCP & EUS to the beginners. Various videos would be shown by the faculty, an expert panel would discuss the individual techniques and conclude with an evidence based approach in each case. The next two days will have a demonstration of variety of endoscopy procedures done by experts, transmitted live from the Asian Institute of Gastroenterology to Hyderabad International Convention Center (HICC). Transmission would be by the new High Definition technology for the first time. There will be ample time for audience interaction and emphasis will be not only be on techniques & technologies but also indications and contra indications for each procedure. Several new techniques like cholangio-pancreaticoscopy, endoscopic radiofrequency ablation of biliary and pancreatic tumors, newer biliary and pancreatic stents will be demonstrated. In addition, endoscopic techniques for removal of difficult biliary and pancreatic stones, selective cannulation of bile duct and pancreatic duct and EUS procedures will also be shown. Physician endoscopists will be introduced to the technique of bed side diagnostic laparoscopy using ultra thin needle laparoscope. Another unique feature of this year's workshop will be Hands on industry session. Delegates can try various accessories hands on at the industry sponsored break out facilities on all three days. There will be a special dinner symposium where the world leaders would share their thoughts on "How they became expert endoscopists"

This conference and workshop would benefit Gastroenterologists, Surgeons, PG students and non specialists with interest in endoscopy and hepato biliary pancreatic diseases. Looking forward to seeing you in Hyderabad which continues to grow as a world class city.
